The Tri-Town YMCA offers children from K to 5th grade in Lombard and Villa Park School District 44 and 45 a variety of age-appropriate after school activities. A typical afternoon schedule might include:

- Active time indoor and outdoor group games and sports
- Creative time arts, crafts, and themed projects
- Homework time for homework and recreational reading
- Group discussions with asset-building and character-development emphasis

Our Philosophy

- Our program provides a enriching environment that allows students to build on skills they learned during the school day, as well to build on creative and social skills.
- Our program is based on the Tri-Town YMCA core values - Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility.

Program Pricing

Note: Deductions for school holidays and half days have been built into the pricing. Therefore, the session payment amounts are **always** the same.

Option 1: Monthly session fees have been determined by spreading costs into 9 equal session fees. 1st payment is due on August 15th. Subsequent payments are due by the 1st of each month.

Option 2: Weekly This 41- session plan is available on an autopay basis (via credit card or deduction from your bank account). First payment is due August 23, 2013; last payment is due by May 30, 2014.

Early Dismissal

At Dist. 45 locations (where "early dismissal" is generally just an hour early) the afterschool program runs as usual beginning at the close of school.

At Dist. 44 locations (where "half day" generally ends at 11:40 a.m.), afterschool care is made available as a separate program for an additional fee to those families who desire it.

Half-day program (Dist. 44 only) \$28/day

Westlake After School CIT (Counselor In Training)

The Tri-Town YMCA now offers an after school CIT program at Glenn Westlake Middle School for grades 6,7, and 8.

The program is structured to teach student leadership by helping out the kids in the YMCA's After School Program at Manor Hill. Students will help lead activities and assist the children with their home work.

Program Cost

\$50 per week M-F

Registration

To secure your child's spot in our before/ after school program, a \$25 registration fee is required. Registration fees are non-refundable if you cancel from the program. If you drop from the program and decide to rejoin, you will pay an additional registration fee.

Payments can be made by mail, E-Mail, or in person at the Tri-Town YMCA office. Payments cannot be made at the school sites. Fee adjustments cannot be made for absences, personal vacations, or school closings.
